

Measure: Diabetic Eye Exam

Diabetic Eye Exam

Population: Patients ages 18-75 with Type 1 and 2 diabetes, who received a screening or monitoring for diabetic retinal disease.

Measurement Range: Prior, or current measure year depending upon exam type.

Required Codes: Evidence of one of the following, refer patient to preferred eye care professional (to include date of service, examination of retina, result and eye care professional)

Retinal or dilated eye exam by eye care professional or results read by a system that provides an artificial intelligence interpretation in the measurement year

Negative retinal or dilated eye exam (negative for retinopathy) in prior year

Bilateral eye enucleation anytime during the patient's history through measurement year

Diabetic retinal screening via retinal camera, image taken by PCP, read by eye specialist **CPT:** 92250
Must include **CPT II**, indicating with/without retinopathy:
2022F-2026F, 2033F, 3072F

Required Exclusion Codes: Patients with gestational diabetes (O24.410-O24.435), steroid-induced diabetes (E09) or polycystic ovarian syndrome (E28.2) in prior or current measurement year. G2081; G2090; G2091; G9687, G9988

**NOTE: Blindness is not an exclusion

Outreach Logic: Included in birthday cards and pre-appointment outreach for patients with diabetes that do not have a documented diabetic eye exam in the current or prior year.
