

Measure: Care & Treatment of Nephropathy

Population: Patients 18–85 years of age with diabetes (Type 1 or 2) who received a kidney health evaluation, defined by an estimated glomerular filtration rate (eGFR) ***and*** a urine albumin-creatinine ratio (uACR).

Measurement Range: Measurement year

Required Codes: Must document with a diagnosis code for diabetes as well as evidence of one of the four applicable codes to satisfy measure.

Nephropathy screening w/urine protein test CPT: 81000-81003, 81005, 82042-82044, 84156	Documented evidence of nephropathy with treatment CPT II: 3066F	ACE/ARB therapy CPT II: 4010F	Visit with a Nephrologist
Microalbuminuria Positive: 3060F or 3062F Negative: 3061F			

Required Exclusion Codes: Gestational diabetes (O24.410-O24.435), medication-induced diabetes (E09), or condition-induced diabetes. G9988; G2090; G2091

Outreach Logic: Included in *birthday cards* and *pre-appointment outreach* for patients with diabetes OR a current diagnosis of Nephropathy. Outreach lists “Nephropathy (Kidney) Screening/Treatment” to cover as appropriate.
