

Measure: Appropriate Treatment: Bronchitis

Population: Patients ages 3 months and older with a diagnosis of acute bronchitis or bronchiolitis who were not dispensed an antibiotic prescription within 3 days.

Measurement Range: Within 3 days of diagnosis

Required Codes: Acute Bronchitis: ICD-10: J20.3-J20.9

Exclusions: Antibiotic prescription during the 30 days before, HIV, malignant neoplasms, emphysema, COPD, cystic fibrosis, disorders of the immune system or comorbid conditions or competing diagnosis of pharyngitis. ED visit that turned into an inpatient admission.
