

## Quality Measures: 2020 Aetna Better Health/Medicaid

### Measure: Breast Cancer Screening \*

Women 52-74 years of age with one or more mammograms within the last 2 years  
(starting age 50)

#### Codes to identify screenings/tests:

### Measure: Comprehensive Diabetes Care \*

Members 18-75 years of age with diabetes should have **HgbA1c testing at least annually**

#### Codes to identify a patient with diabetes:

| Description      | Codes  |

### Measure: Adolescent Well Care Visits \*

Members **12-21 years of age** with at least one comprehensive well care visit with a primary care practitioner or an OB/GYN annually.

**Minimum of 1 Required**

#### Codes to identify adolescent health exams:

| Description      | Codes  |
|------------------|--|
| ICD-10 Diagnosis | Z00.121 -Z00.129, Z00.5, Z00.8,<br>Z02.0-Z02.9 |

#### Codes to identify screenings/tests:

| Description | Codes                    |

| HCPCS       | G0438, G0439             |

**Never miss an opportunity! Exam requirements can be performed during a sick visit or a well visit.**

Documentation **MUST include ALL three** criteria:

- health and developmental history
- physical exam
- health education/guidance

### Measure: Emergency Department Utilization/Visits

Tracking of Emergency Department visits of Members to **identify potentially avoidable visits.**

- This does not include ED visits that result in an inpatient stay.
- Multiple visits to the ED in one day only count as one visit.
- Exclude visits for mental health or chemical dependency.

## **Measure: PCR – Plan All-Cause Readmissions**

For all Members regardless of age, the percentage of acute inpatient stays during the measurement year followed by an **unplanned acute readmission** for any diagnosis within 30 days.

- Count of 30-Day Readmissions
- Index Hospital Stays (IHS)
