Measure: Kidney health evaluation for patients with diabetes

Population: Patients 18–85 years of age with diabetes (Type 1 and Type 2) who have received a kidney health evaluation defined by an estimated glomerular filtration rate (eGFR) and a urine albumin-creatinine rate (uACR) during the measurement year.

Measurement Range: Measurement year

Required Codes: eGFR (CPT: 80047, 80048, 80050, 80053, 80069, 82565) as well as:

At least one albumin-creatinine ratio lab test (uACR) **OR** Both a quantitative urine albumin test (CPT: 82043) and a urine creatinine test (CPT: 82570) with date of service 4 days or less apart.

Exclusions: Gestational diabetes, medication-induced diabetes, or condition-induced diabetes. Palliative care assessment, encounter or intervention. 66 years and older with 1 claim for frailty device, diagnosis, encounter or symptom within the measurement year, AND advanced illness.
