

Population: Women ages 67-85 who suffered a fracture and had either a bone mineral density test or received an osteoporosis prevention prescription.

Measurement Range: Bone mineral density (BMD) test, 2 years prior to fracture or received a prescription in the 6 months after fracture.

Required Process/Codes: Must include the bone mineral density test and results.
CPT: 76977-77078; 77080-77081; 77085-77086. Therapy medication injections: J0897, J1740, J3110, J3111, J3489.

Exclusions: Documented fracture of face, skull, finger or toe. BMD test during 24 months prior to the fracture, dispensed/active prescription to treat osteoporosis during 12 months prior to fracture. Claim/encounter for osteoporosis therapy during 12 months prior to fracture. Patients 67 and older in LTC, SNF, with advanced illness or frailty in prior or current measurement year. Hospice or palliative care.
